7. Participation:

This event is open to all parties in the specified age groups. The tournament categories mentioned below are suggested and could change depending on the number of teams and participants. Also, in case of limited participants, the Organizers may combine categories and create mixed gender tournament categories.

8. Duration of contest:

U16-U20	4 minutes
U13	2 minutes

9. Eligibility

The age limitation for the categories is as given above.

10. Number of Entries

Each delegation can bring a maximum of 2 athletes per weight (negotiable).

11. Invitees

This is an invitational so only invited teams are eligible to participate.

12. Competition Rules

- The competition bouts will consist of quarterfinal repechage system. In the event that a category has 5 players or less, the round robin system will be applied.
- The International Judo Federation Match Referee Regulations shall apply.
- The decision of the referees shall be final.

13. Judogi Control

- White Judogi and Blue Judogi are RECOMMENDED but not COMPULSORY.

14. Weigh - in

Weigh-in will be carried out one day before the competition at 5pm. Players who are either underweight or overweight will be automatically disqualified from his/her event. All participants are required to bring their Identity Card or Passport during the weigh-in.

15. Draw

The drawing of lots will be done the evening before the tournament. To avoid confusion, all teams must make sure that the list of participants is complete and accurate before submission. Last minute changes will not be entertained.

16. Team Referees:

Hotel expense will be covered by organizer for the referees who come with the team.

17. Awards

- Tournaments: Medals and Certificates

18. Special note

- Match Manners
Ensure the proper etiquette before and after the match. Compete with respect for your opponent. Respect decision of the referees. Even if it seems mistaken.
- Spectator Manners
Excessive cheering that interferes with the progress of the game is prohibited. After the match, applaud and praise the competitors.

19. Competition Registration Fees:

Participation fees will be applied as follows:

INDIVIDUAL EVENT:	USD 50 per entry
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20. Visas and Sustainable Development Fee

- Bhutan Visa form to be filled by all nationals excluding visitors from Bangladesh, Maldives and India who will pay for visa on arrival. More details are available at www.mfa.gov.bt/visa/. Please complete the pre-filled form issued by BJA.
- There's a \$30 visa fee + \$30 processing fee.
- \$100/day SDF Fee will be exempted under sports visa if registered early.

21. Travel costs

Overseas participants are responsible for their own travel arrangements and costs. The organizer will be glad to assist in finding the most affordable options.

22. Airfare on Bhutan carriers

There are two airline carriers that fly into Bhutan, Druk Air and Bhutan Airlines. Teams can fly to Paro International Airport (PBH), Bhutan from Kathmandu, New Delhi, Kolkata, Bagdogra, Bangkok or Dhaka. Alternatively, teams can land in Bagdogra (India) and drive by bus to Thimphu (an 8-hour drive). This will be cheaper but takes a day longer and India visas will also be required. The organizer will provide support if required. If team confirmations are made early, the organizer shall attempt to get a discount on the airfare though this is not guaranteed.

23. Accommodation and Food and transport

The Organizer shall arrange room and board at the following rates:

- Hotel Room (double occupancy): US\$60/night per person 3 meals.
- Mini-bus (25-seater) daily hire rate: US\$100/day for local duty (optional for teams)

24. Responsibility of Teams:

The respective teams shall bear full responsibility for the health and safety of their team members. Each Team is responsible for insuring its competitors against injury and thirdparty risk (public liability) during the period of the tournament. By registering for this event, the team management indemnifies the organizer of all responsibility. Each team's Manager must produce parental consent for traveling to Bhutan and participating in the event.

25. Insurance:

Each Team will assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liability for their contestants and officials. The Organizing Committee of the Championship, and Bhutan Judo Association will not be responsible for any claims of illness, injury and death, of any participants/officials whatsoever.

26. First Aid & Medical Coverage:

First aid assistance will be provided throughout the competition. Injuries requiring further medical attention will be directed to the closest hospital and further treatment will be at your own expense.

27. Amendment & Addendums

The organizing committee reserves the rights to make any changes in the event if necessary or amend the championship instructions without notice, to ensure the safe and successful conclusion of the championship.

28. Deadlines

As May falls within the tourist season, flights and hotels will be both more expensive and harder to get, if not booked early. Therefore, early confirmations are requested.

- Final List and Visa Application Form: NO LATER THAN 21 April, 2025
